2020 IHA Annual Convention

IHA's Board of Directors has made the difficult decision to cancel this year's convention scheduled for October 5-8.

Reimbursement & Policy

PPP loan terms changed with new bill

Yesterday, the Senate approved the Paycheck Protection Program Flexibility Act of 2020 which was passed in the House last week and is expected to be signed by the President.

The bill makes changes to PPP loans which were originally adopted in the CARES Act. Among the changes made is a modification to the non-payroll spending limit. Originally, non-payroll related costs were limited to 25% of the loan in order to qualify for forgiveness. That threshold will be increased to 40%.

HHS issues guidance for laboratory reporting

Today, HHS released [new guidance](#) specifying what data labs must report along with their COVID-19 test results, the method for submission, and the data reporting and transmission requirements. HHS will require all labs to report results for each test completed within 24 hours of results for each individual tested. According to the guidance, labs generally should send the data to state or local public health departments using existing reporting channels to ensure case investigations begin rapidly.
